How to book

Speak to your unit CO or training officer and ask them to book online via Westminster. Secure your place with a signed consent form and by sending a £50 deposit. Please make cheques payable to MSSC and send to the National Booking Centre or for credit card payments please call: 023 9276 5046.

Voyage information

The offshore season is between March and November, each voyage is for six nights. You join the vessel on Saturday at 2pm and depart at 9am the following Friday unless otherwise stated. You will need to travel to join your vessel and please remember that often the joining and departure ports will be different, so check before booking and also check if you need a passport and European Health Insurance Card.

Cost

£275 per cadet including travel to and from the vessel. Bursaries that help part fund voyages are available in some instances, contact your CO, district, area office or National Booking Centre for more details and how to apply.

TS VIGILANT AND TS CITY LIVERYMAN: YACHTS

Sail an RYA accredited 35ft yacht. This experience is ideal for those wanting to progress their RYA qualifications.

Places: Five cadet berths per yacht.

Age restrictions: 13½ up to 18

Bookings are made via Westminster for individuals and unit or district bookings are encouraged.

A volunteer from your unit is not needed, however if you have a qualified Offshore endorsed mate available please contact Offshore Office.



TS ROYALIST (BRIG) - A TALL SHIP

Take advantage of a unique opportunity to sail our brand new square rigger. This takes teamwork and offers the challenge of handling sails. Watchkeeping duties and deck work are also a part of the experience.

Places: Royalist takes 24 cadets and no supervisors are needed. A total of six cadets (booked individually) from any one unit can join.

Age restrictions: 131/2 up to 18



TS JOHN JERWOOD & TS JACK PETCHEY: POWER TRAINING VESSELS

Experience sea training onboard a modern power vessel. You'll learn navigation, bridge team duties, seamanship, deck work, engineering, catering plus experience other duties needed to operate a vessel at sea.

Places: A minimum of two cadets (plus a supervisor) or up to 12 cadets (with two

supervisors*, one male and one female)

Age restrictions: 12 up to 18

Please check with National Booking Centre for accommodation restrictions.

*Voyage fee not applicable to supervisors
