

SEA CADETS LOTTERY FAQs

Q: What is the Sea Cadets lottery?

We have partnered with Unity lottery (run by Sterling Management Centre) in order to offer our supporters the chance to support the charity through a weekly lottery.

Q: Why are Sea Cadets running a lottery?

Our lottery helps to raise essential unrestricted funds in order for us to support cadets throughout the UK.

Q: How much are tickets?

It costs £4.34 a month and is paid by subscription but can be cancelled at any time.

Q. How does it work?

Playing is simple: Players pay just £1 per week for a unique six-digit lottery number. You can buy up to 20 lottery numbers for a greater chance to win. Numbers are entered into a weekly draw, with various prizes including a £25,000 jackpot! We send cheques directly to the winners every week. For the full rules please see the Unity website.

Q How much of my money goes to the charity?

Sea Cadets receives 50p per entry. The other 50p is split into two parts, approximately 25p goes towards the prize fund, and the 25p remaining goes to pay for the administration behind Unity.

Who is behind Unity?

Unity lotteries are administered by Sterling Management Centre who have been lottery administrators for over 30 years. They are a team of 42 experienced staff operating in Cumbria.

How will I find out if I have won?

The winning members will be forwarded their prizes automatically by post each week directly following the draw. The winning numbers will also be available on the Unity winner's hotline, and the Unity website.

What are the odds of our players winning a prize?

The odds of winning any prize are 1 in 63.

Q: How old do I have to be to enter?

You must be over 16 to take part. When signing up online you will need to declare your date of birth and that you are over 16.

Q: What is responsible gambling?

Responsible gambling means staying in control of how much time and money we spend on gambling. Responsible gambling means not spending more money or time than we can reasonably afford on gambling activities, keeping in mind all our other responsibilities in life.

Q: I think I may have a problem with gambling, how can I get help?
