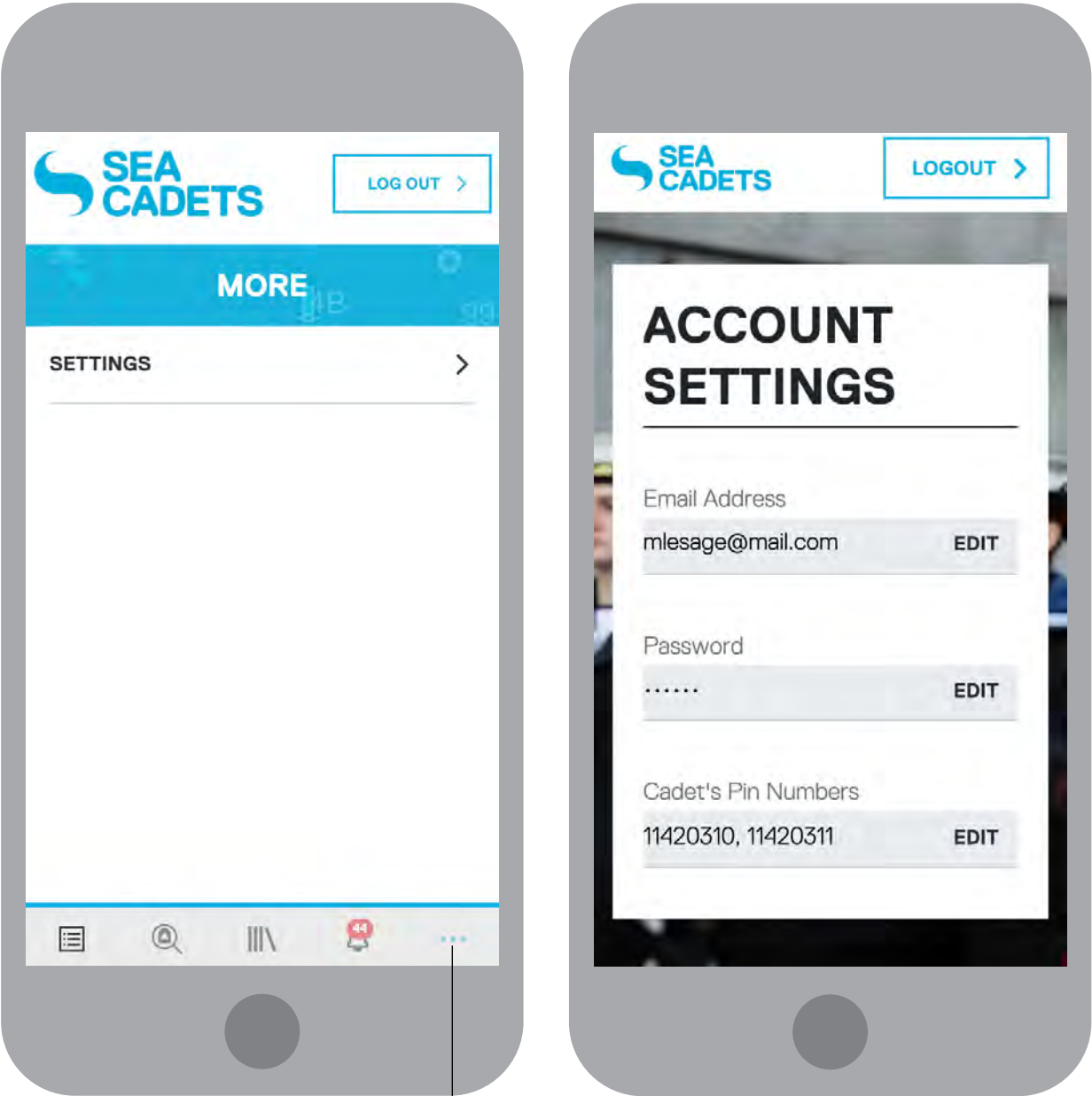
Select this box to set up your portal account.



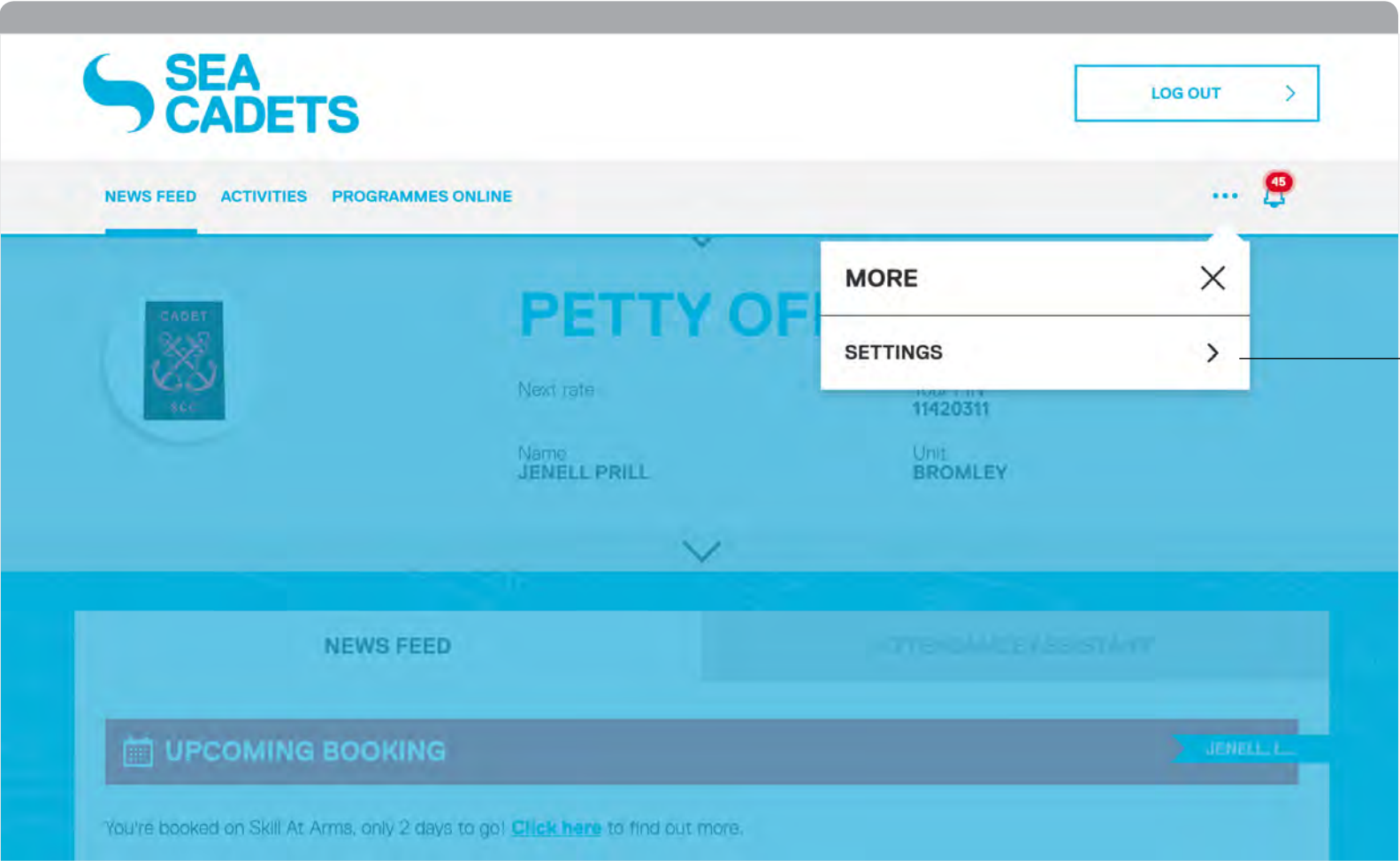


Enter your information as well your cadet/s PIN number/s. Once you have filled in all of the fields, select the 'SIGN UP' button to create your account.

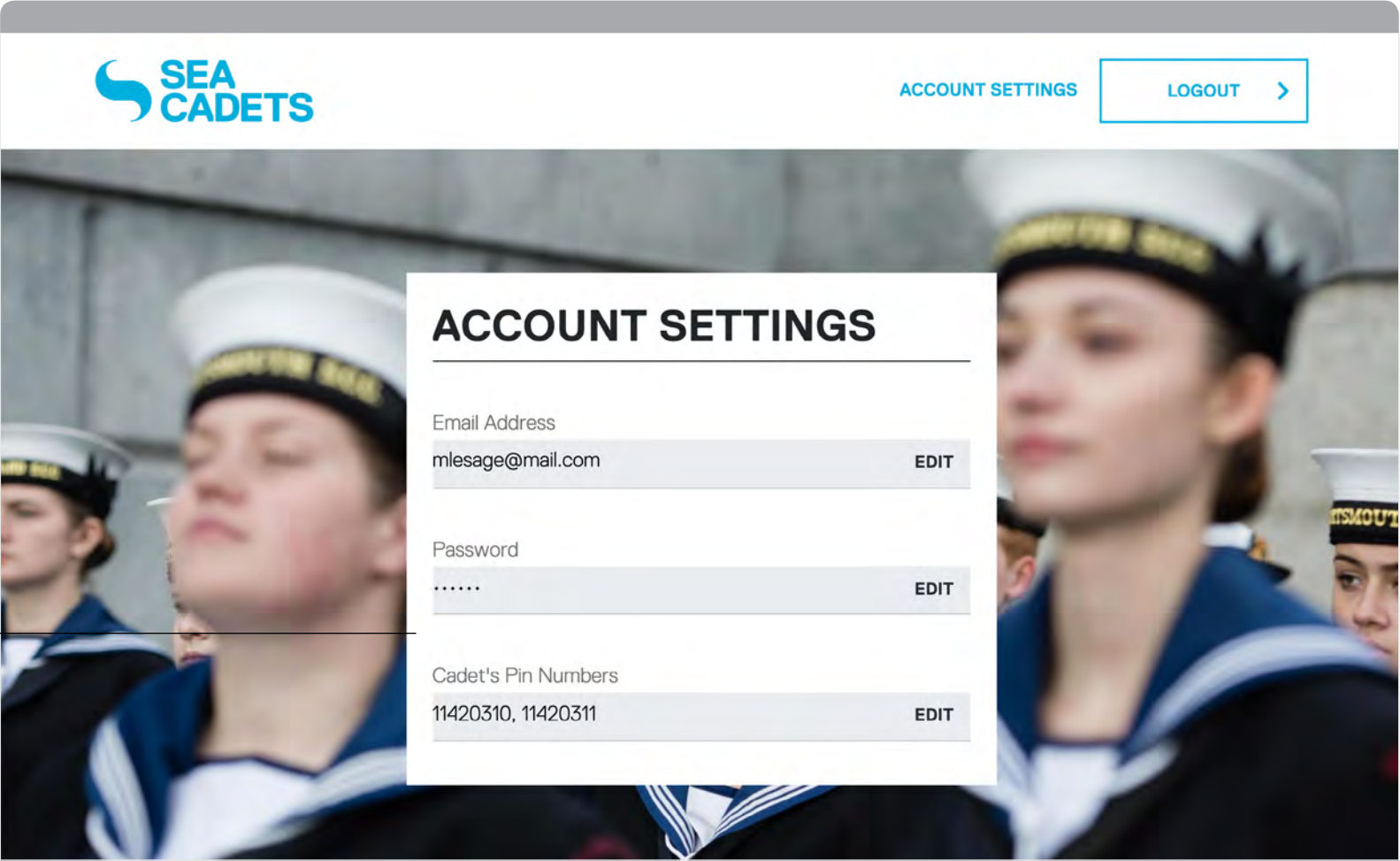

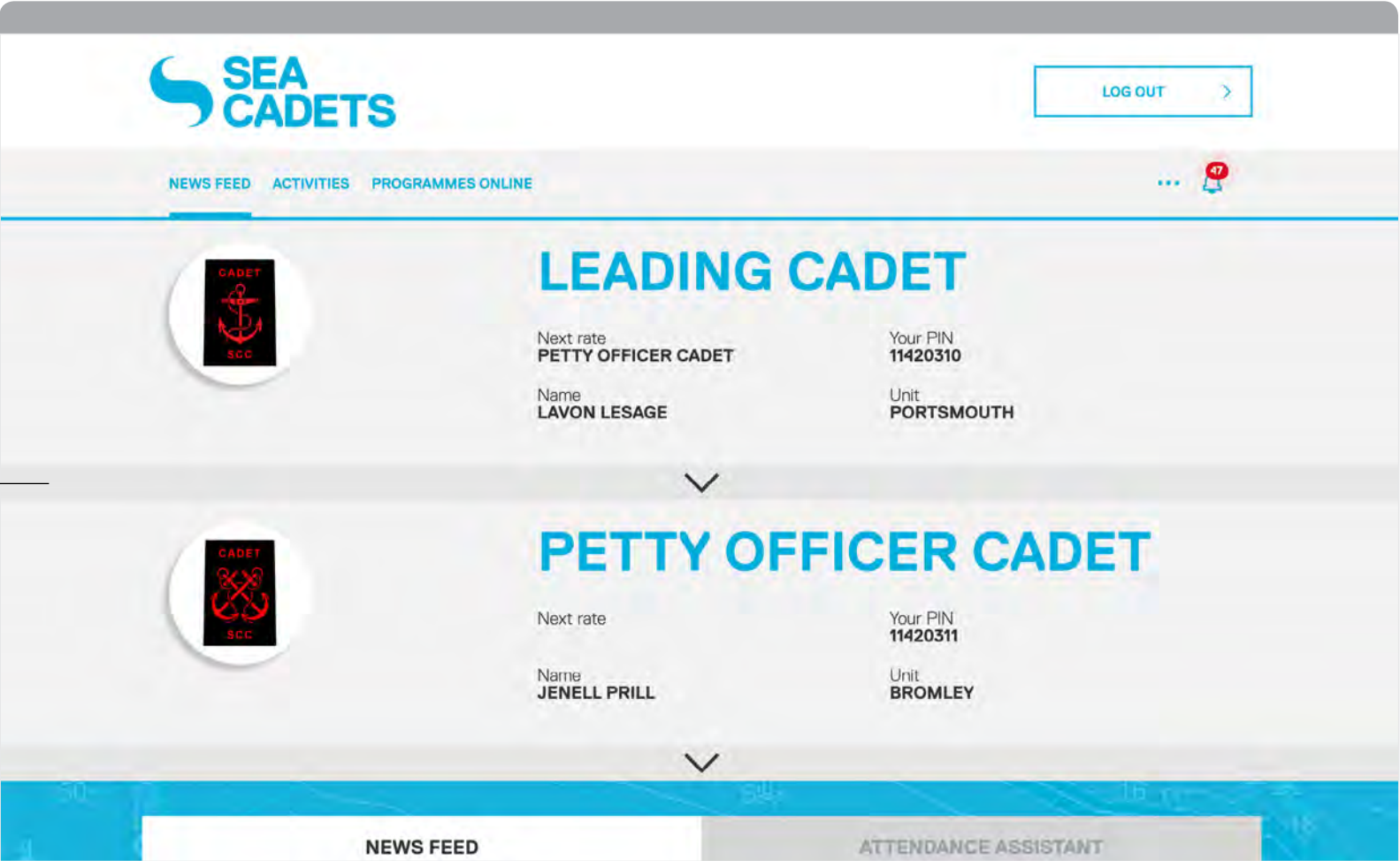
Access your account settings through the menu.



Here you can edit your account information, and also add another cadet to your account.

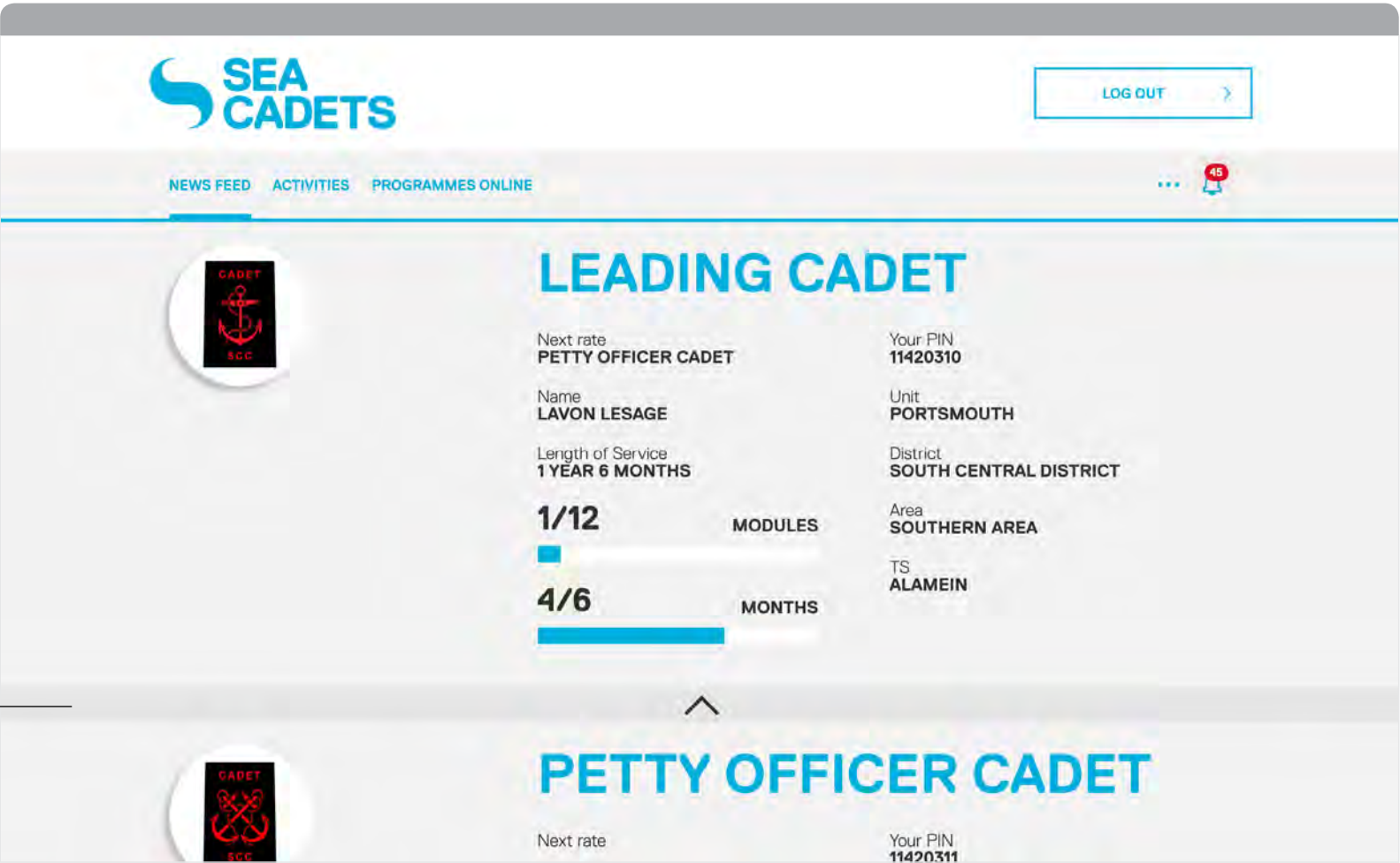


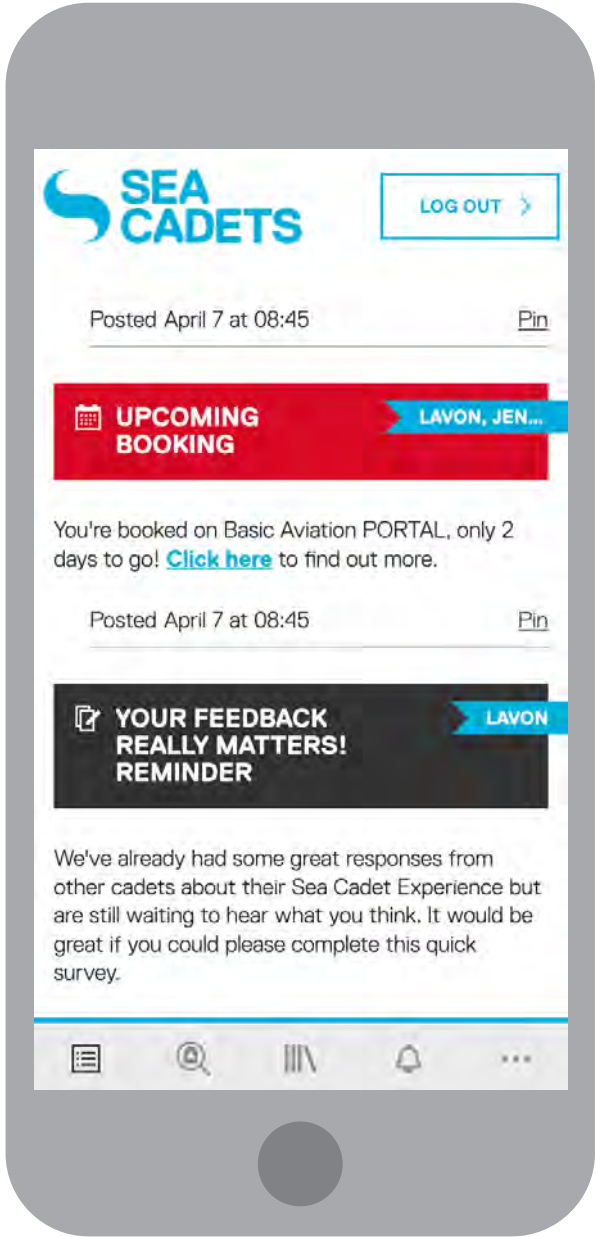
Clicking this arrow will reveal more information about one of your cadets.



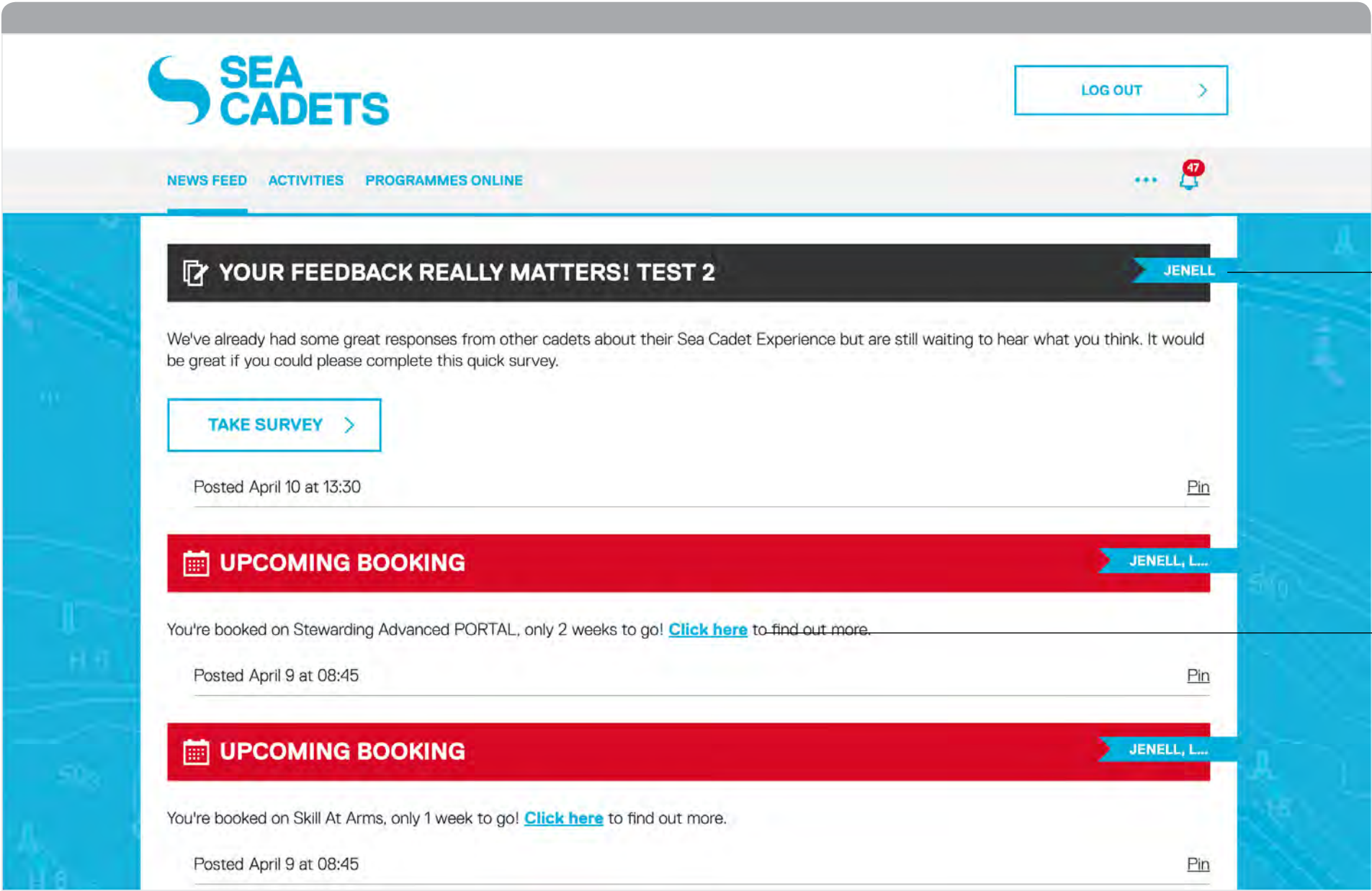
This is the expanded state of the cadet info section. Here you will find lots of useful information.

Click the arrow again to hide the information.



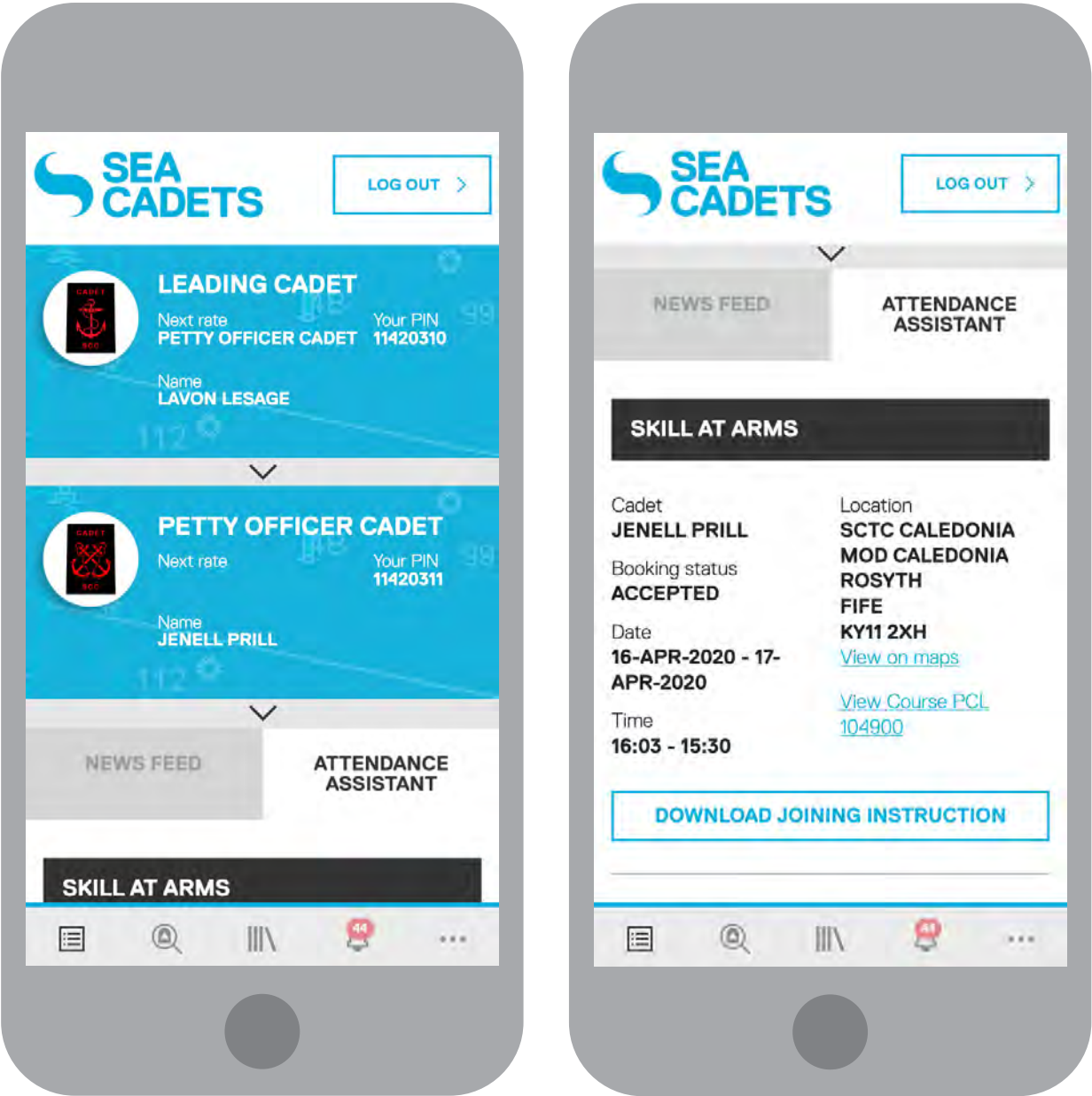


The news feed is populated with content relevant to each of your cadets.

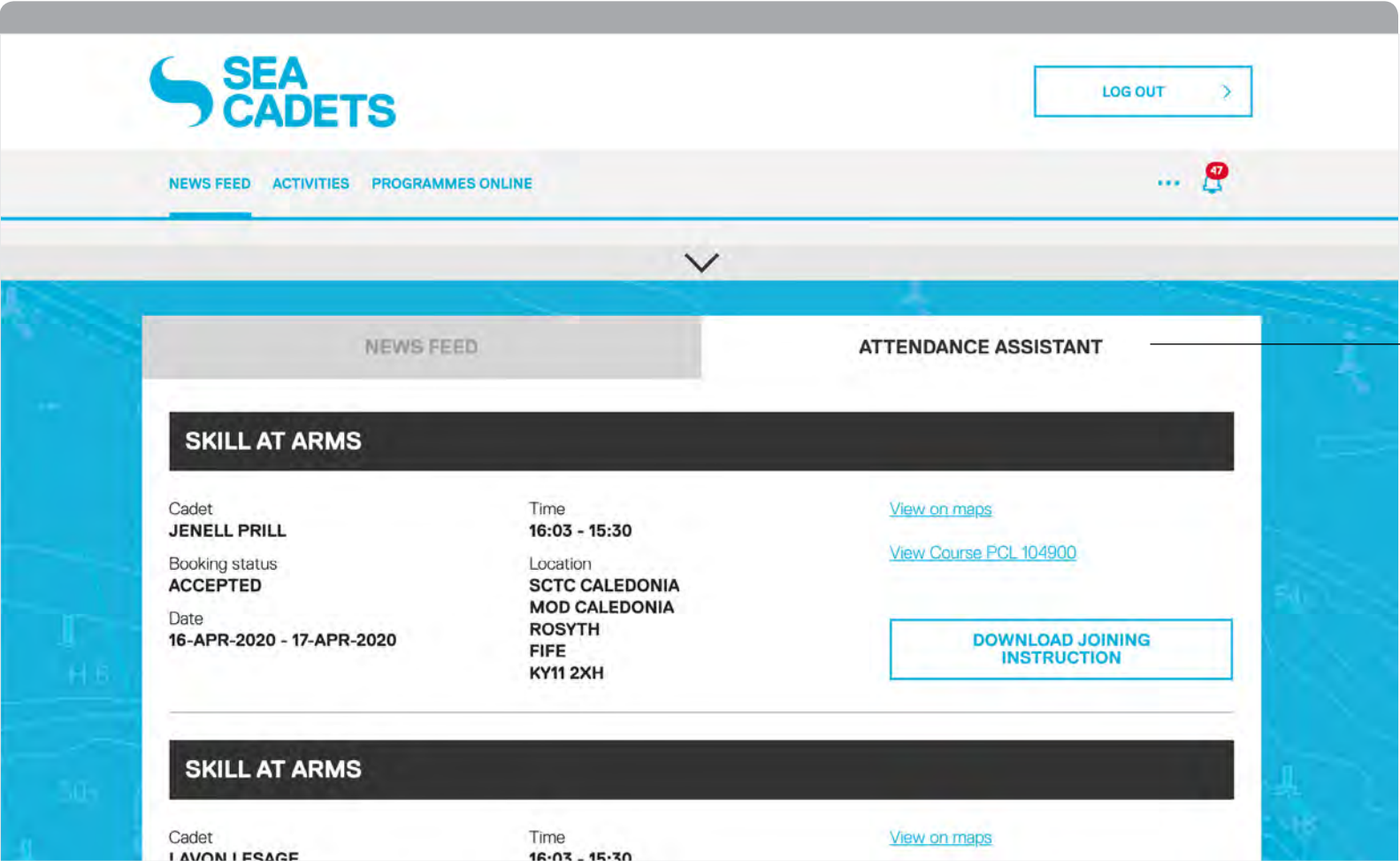


This tab lets you know which cadet this information is relevant to.

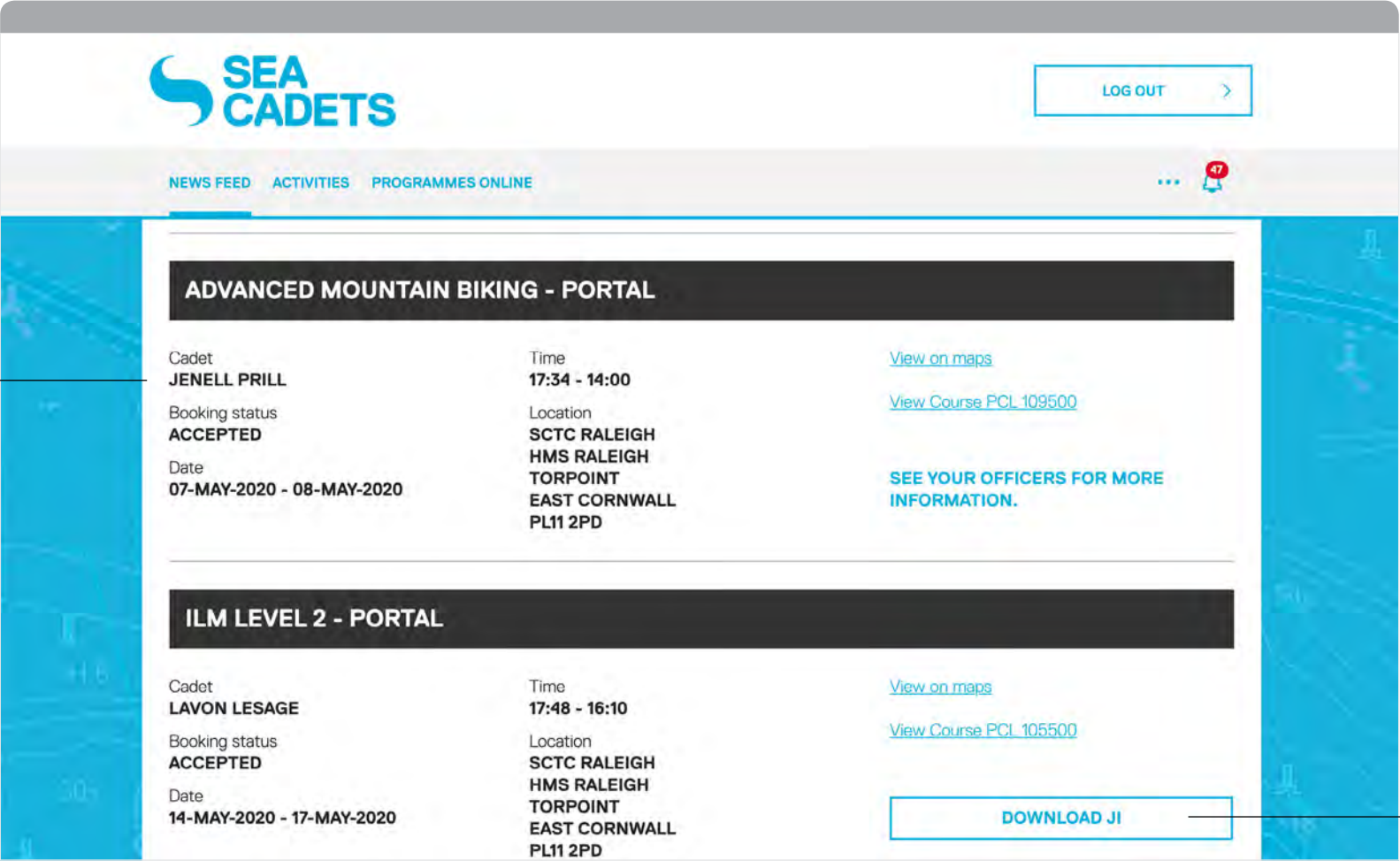
You can select these blue links to access more information about the booking.



The Attendance Assistant is a place where you can find information about activities or event that your cadets are booked onto.

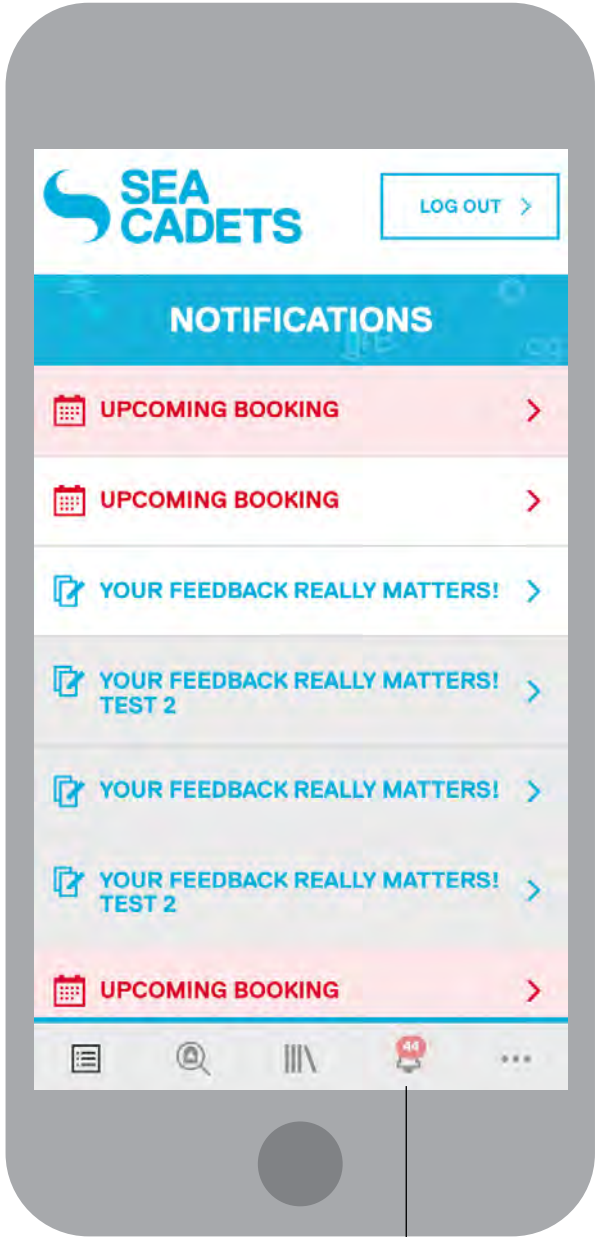


You can access it by selecting the 'ATTENDANCE ASSISTANT' tab when on the news feed.

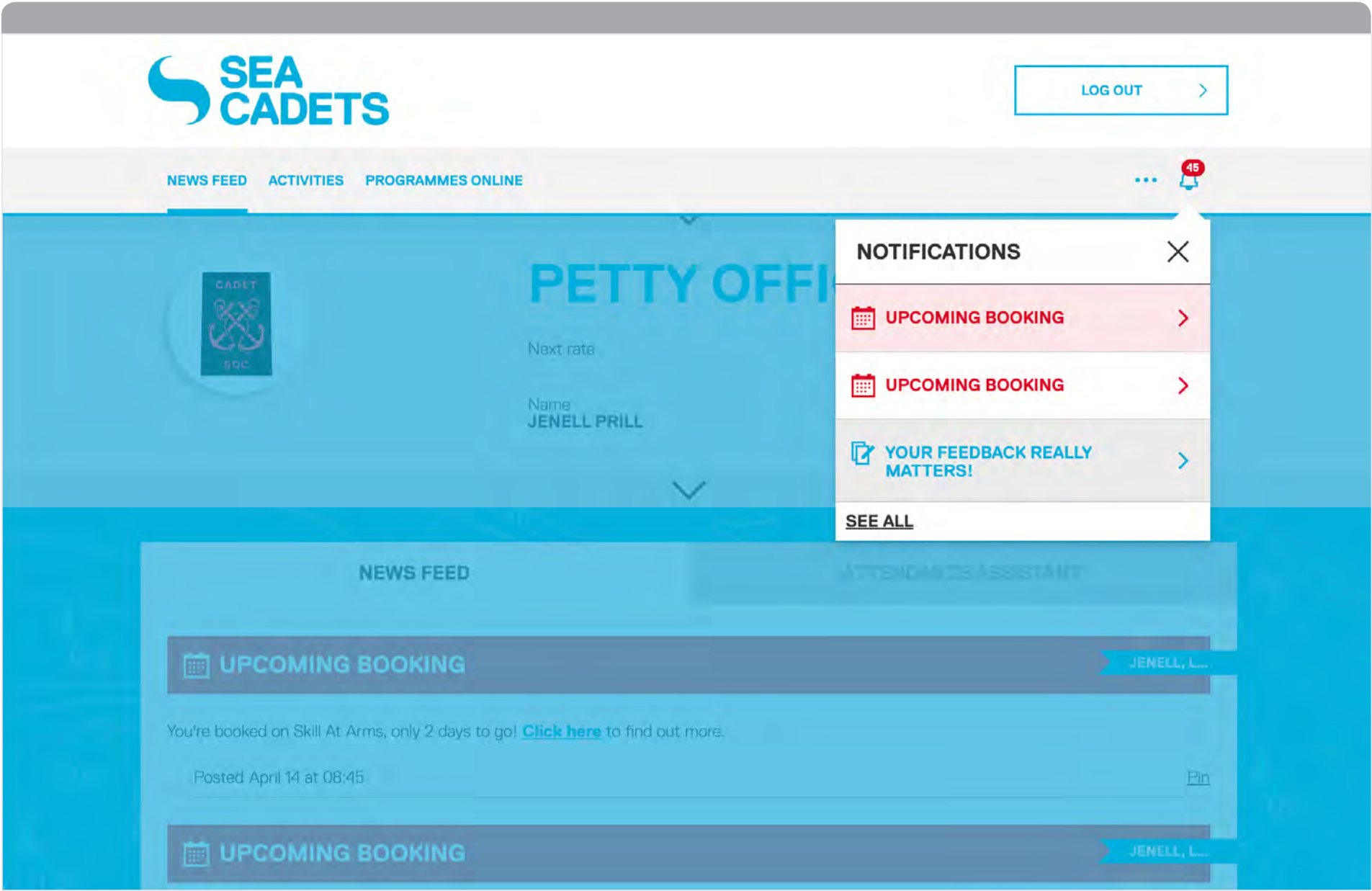


Each booking will show which cadet it is relevant to, and other general information.

You will sometimes be able to download more information about the booking in PDF form.



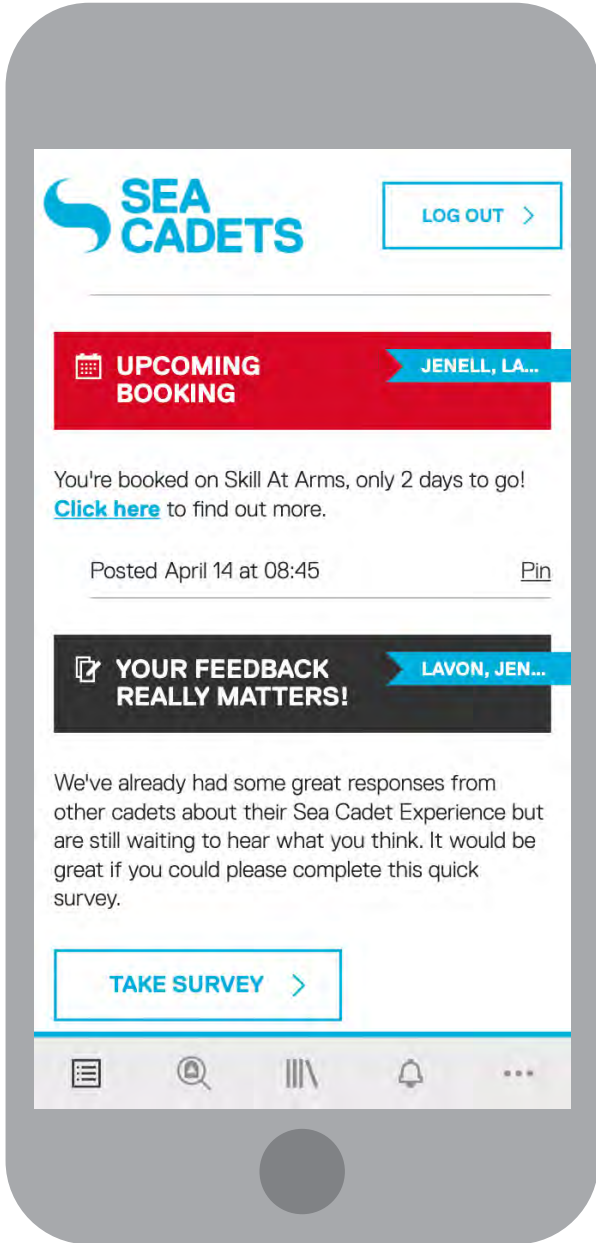
Click this icon to access the notifications page.
